HEALTH INSURANCE / TB TEST

Every student attending BYU-I is required to have health insurance. If you use your own health care or a parents, submit a [Student Health Plan Waiver](#). If you don't have your own, you will be enrolled in the BYU-I Health Plan. All students will be prompted to complete the Tuberculosis (TB) screening questionnaire. Look [here](#) for the TB test requirements to see if you will need one.
